We are accepting grant applications for Summer 2019 for funding to local not for profit organizations located in or directly serving Hudson. Grant requests are welcomed for charitable projects and activities that address needs and opportunities specific to the local community in the areas of arts, culture, education, environmental, historical, preservation, human service, youth, and community development that would improve quality of life in Hudson.

Applications must be completed and submitted by Thursday, August 1, 2019.

Organizations that have received grants prior to 2019 and wish to apply again must first have submitted a final report for any previously funded projects or programs to be eligible for funds again. The final report deadlines may vary.

The Foundation's grant funding results from the generosity of donors who have contributed to specific and unrestricted funds established at the Foundation. Contributions are accepted throughout the year and can be made online.
